This guide gives a brief introduction to the variety of sources available for the parish of Albrighton near Shifnal at Shropshire Archives.

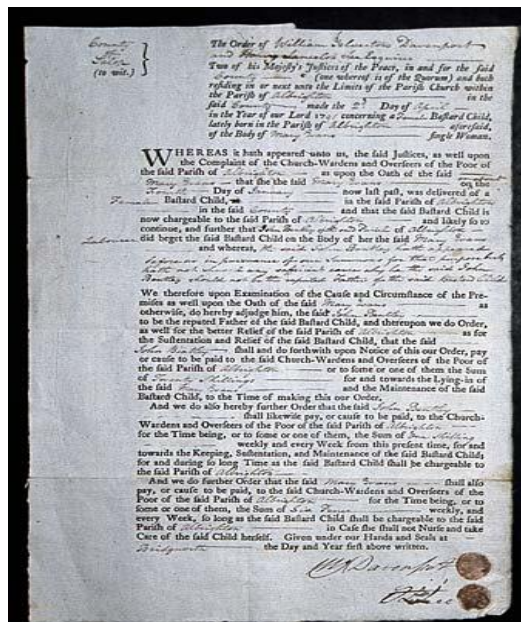
