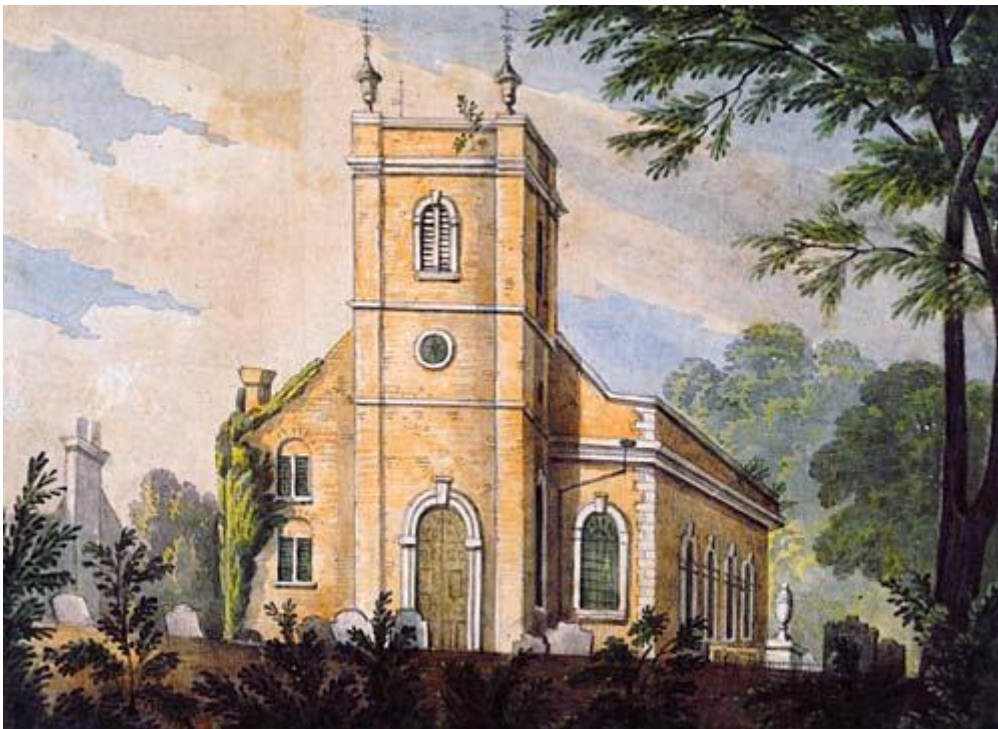
## Sources for CHETWYND
