This guide gives a brief introduction to the variety of sources available for Clive at Shropshire Archives.

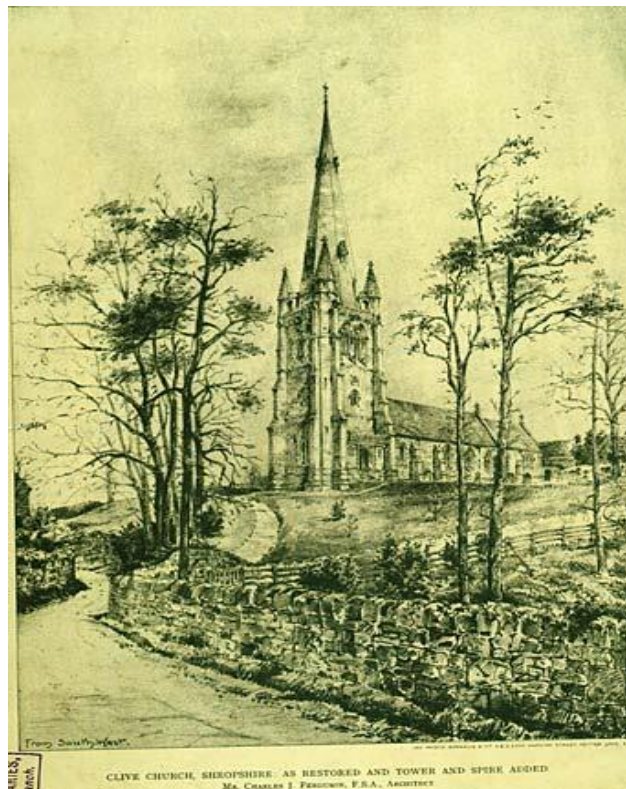
