This guide gives a brief introduction to the variety of sources available for **Hadnall** at Shropshire Archives.

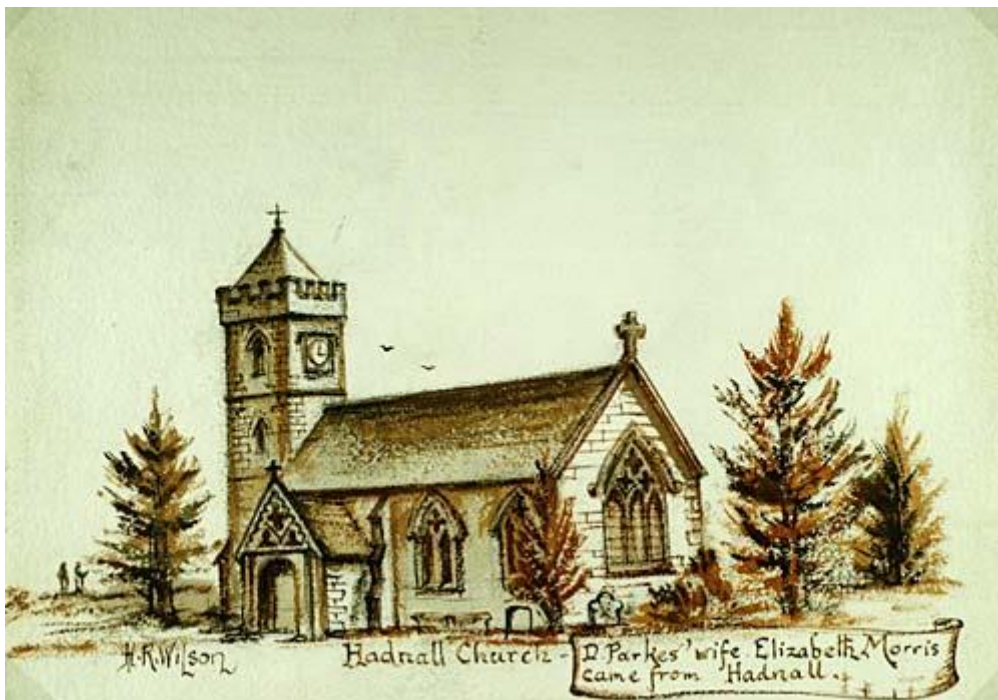
