St. Paul's church in Knowbury was first built in 1839 and consecrated on St. Paul's day, the 28th June, in 1840. Alterations were made to the church less than fifty years later, between 1883 and 1885, when Lord Windsor paid for a new chancel to be built and for the tower to be erected. 6009/121
