This guide gives a brief introduction to the variety of sources available for the parish of **Neen Savage** at Shropshire Archives.

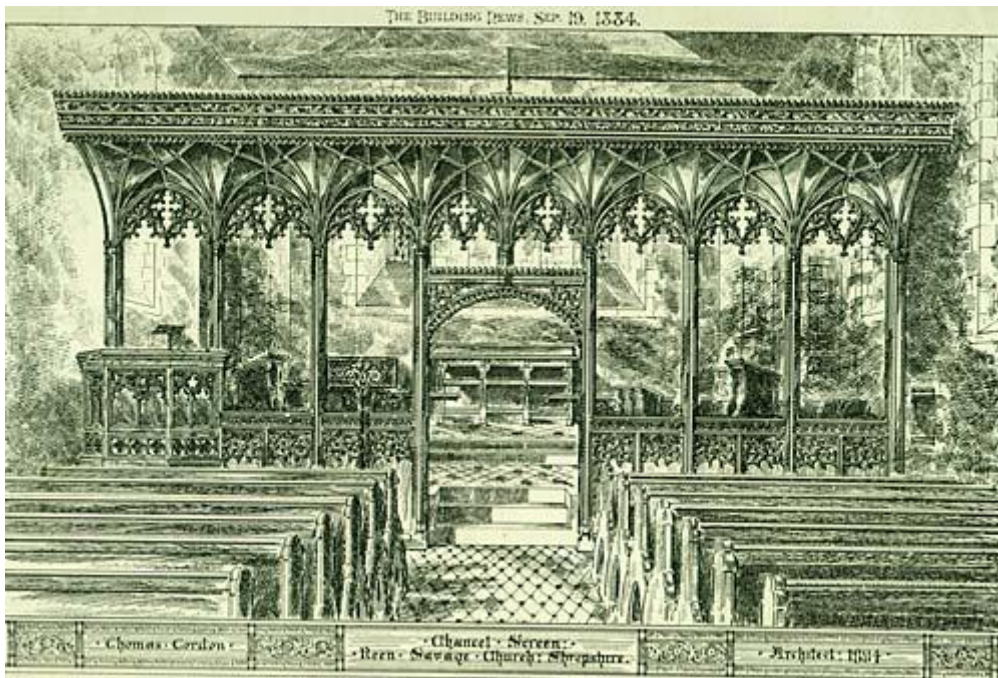
