**"THE LUDLOW CASTLE HERALDIC ROLL:
A WINDOW INTO TUDOR TIMES"**

Spied in a London antique shop in 2012 and dating from c. 1580, the Ludlow Heraldic roll contains 42 coats of arms of some of the owners of Ludlow castle, presidents and members of the Council in the Marches of Wales from the 11th century to the 16th. A successful appeal was launched to secure the roll for Ludlow, and the preservation and analysis of this fascinating artefact could begin. It raised thought-provoking questions about why the President of the Council, Sir Henry Sidney had the roll made? What can we find out about who might have painted the coats of arms, and the materials they used? What insights does the roll give us into 16th century Ludlow? Who were the people whose coats of arms are featured? This conference answers these questions and more.
